Attendance Up:

Visitation and signs being put up have increased our attendance over the last few months. The room we are using for meeting is in the process of having a new floor installed and the room has been expanded to handle the growing crowd. Our next project is more chairs! Praise the Lord. After the cholera epidemic ended the numbers of people coming to church is steadily increasing.

Medical Clinic Coming:

This last week was spent with Dr. and Mrs. Waller with Truth for Today medical missions. Dr. Waller organizes teams of medical and non-medical personnel to conduct free medical clinics. The clinics meet medical needs of people who often have little or no access to medical care. In addition each person coming to the clinic will have the opportunity to hear the gospel one on one with a trained soul winner. The free gift of medical care is a powerful illustration of the free gift of salvation offered to all by Jesus Christ.

The clinic will be held Oct. 29th – Nov 3rd. Flights will leave the USA on the 26th of October and will arrive back in the USA on the 7th of November. This is a great opportunity for a missions trip for anyone who would enjoy leading many souls to Christ. We are in need of people who can assist in the medical clinic – both trained medical personnel and non-trained. We can also use people in the soul winning area. Pray about coming and seeing the work here in Zambia.

If you would like a crash course in soul winning, I can honestly not think of any better mission's trip to go on. Imagine this, a person arrives and we have an intensive soul winning class the day before the clinic. Then the person can spend a day with an experienced soul winner and see the gospel presented to people back to back for 10 hours+. Once comfortable they can present the gospel up to 100 times in a day. In a morning the new soul winner could present the gospel to more people than most Christians do in a decade. People who were never soul winners can return to the USA with a new found burden and skill in presenting the Gospel.

Utilities Arriving, Construction Progressing:

The city water pipe has now been installed at the church. Soon a baptistery can be installed! Sewer and power are next. The next major project is a wall. The church needs a block wall for security. I have resisted this a bit, but it is the norm here. The men of the church are in unanimous agreement that this is vital to the security of the church. Along with the wall will be proper flush toilets and the decommissioning of the unsanitary pit latrines. This project will cost about \$6,500. Please pray for this project, the funding of it, and the implementation of it.
